

BALLET WITH MS. RIO

COVID-19 PROCEDURES as of 1/5/2022

General

- Prior to coming to ballet class, please check your child's temperature, or your own if registered for the adult class. Those experiencing symptoms such as coughing, shortness of breath, difficulty breathing, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell, and those who have had close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID-19 are prohibited from attending class in person.
- If you or your child are exhibiting one or more of the symptoms listed above, please contact Ms. Rio at info@dancerio.com to ensure the dancer's proper return.
- Masks that completely cover the nose and mouth and fit snugly against the sides of face are required for all students, and must remain on throughout the duration of class. Parents and caregivers are also to wear masks when entering the building. Please do not use masks with exhalation valves or vents.
- Students are to socially distance whenever possible.
- Hand sanitizing stations have been placed in and near the studio to allow for students to sanitize before, during and after class.
- Community mats used in Adult classes will not be available. Adult students are welcome to bring their own mats, or do the floor work without a mat.

Vaccinations

- **Niles Family Fitness Center** students 19 years & up must show proof of vaccination when entering the building, along with identification (including but not limited to driver's license, passport, government ID, work or school ID) with information that corresponds to the vaccination proof. Please be advised, students aged 5-18 years old will no longer have to show proof of vaccination.
- Ballet with Ms. Rio's programs at all other locations will be adhering to the COVID-19 vaccination proof procedures set by each location. Updates will be posted as they are received. Please contact your location's administration for more information.
