

# **BALLET WITH MS. RIO**

## **UNIFORM CODE**

### **Pre-Ballet Girls:**

- *Interclub, NFFC & GPD*: Pink leotard, Pink mid-thigh pull on skirt (not tutu or wrap tie skirt)\*, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes (no drawstrings please), Hair in ballet bun or ponytail. (\*Skirts may be attached to leotard or not; it's up to you!)
- *D63 FRC, MSW, SPC & St. Juliana Schools*: Pink leather ballet shoes (no drawstrings), Hair pulled back off of face. A pink mid-thigh pull on skirt is encouraged, but not mandatory. (Skirt should not be attached to a leotard unless a parent is present to change the child.)

### **Primary Ballet Girls:**

- *Interclub, NFFC & GPD*: Black leotard, Black mid-thigh pull on skirt (not tutu or wrap tie skirt)\*, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes (no drawstrings please), Hair in ballet bun. (\*Skirts may be attached to leotard or not; it's up to you!)
- *D63 FRC, MSW, SPC & St. Juliana Schools*: Pink leather ballet shoes (no drawstrings), Hair pulled back off of face. The uniform above is encouraged, but not mandatory.

### **Level 1 and Level 1&2 Ballet Girls (Tues/Thurs):**

- Black leotard (no skirt), Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes, Hair in ballet bun

### **Level 2 and Level 2&3 Ballet Girls (Wed/Fri/Sat):**

- Royal blue leotard, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes, Hair in ballet bun

### **All Ballet Boys:**

- *Interclub, NFFC & GPD*: White t-shirt, Black shorts or leggings, Black ballet shoes. Black mid-calf socks are optional.
- *D63 FRC, MSW, SPC & St. Juliana Schools*: Black ballet shoes. The uniform above is encouraged, but not mandatory.

### **Pre-Pointe:**

- Students must bring a [Yellow Thera-Band®](#). Uniform is the same as Level 2&3 Ballet.

### **All Tap and Jazz Classes (Girls & Boys):**

- Black tap shoes. Black pants/leggings are encouraged, but not mandatory. For classes that include Jazz, dancers may wear black jazz shoes or any color ballet shoes.

### **Adults:**

- Ballet attire is welcome, but not required. Most attendees wear general exercise clothing with socks or ballet shoes. Sneakers and mats for the cardio and floor barre portions of the Wednesday class are optional (and not necessary for the Saturday class).
