

BALLET WITH MS. RIO

UNIFORM CODE

Pre-Ballet Girls:

- *Interclub, GPD & PV Montessori*: Pink leotard, Pink mid-thigh pull on skirt (not a wrap tie skirt or tutu)*, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes without drawstrings, Hair in ballet bun or ponytail. (*Skirts may be attached to leotard or not; it's up to you!)
- *MSW, SPC & SJS*: Pink leather ballet shoes without drawstrings, Hair pulled back off of face. A pink mid-thigh pull on skirt is encouraged, but not mandatory. (Skirt should not be attached to a leotard unless a parent is present to change the child.)

Primary & Intro to Ballet Girls:

- *Interclub, GPD & PV Montessori*: Black leotard, Black mid-thigh pull on skirt (not a wrap tie skirt or tutu)*, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes without drawstrings, Hair in ballet bun. (*Skirts may be attached to leotard or not; it's up to you!)
- *MSW, SPC, SJS & D63 FRC*: Pink leather ballet shoes without drawstrings, Hair pulled back off of face. The uniform above is encouraged, but not mandatory.

Level 1 and Level 1&2 Ballet Girls (Tues/Thurs/Sat):

- Black leotard (no skirt), Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes, Hair in ballet bun

Level 2 and Level 2&3 Ballet Girls (Mon/Wed/Sat):

- Royal blue leotard, Pink full footed tights, Pink leather ballet shoes, Hair in ballet bun

All Ballet Boys:

- *Interclub, GPD & PV Montessori*: White t-shirt, Black shorts or leggings, Black ballet shoes. Black or White mid-calf socks are optional.
- *MSW, SPC, SJS & D63 FRC*: Black ballet shoes. The uniform above is encouraged, but not mandatory.

Pre-Pointe:

- Students must bring a [Yellow Thera-Band®](#).

All Tap, Jazz & Lyrical Classes (Girls & Boys):

- Black pants/leggings are encouraged for non-ballet classes, but not mandatory. Black tap shoes worn with socks or tights are required for Tap classes. For Jazz, dancers may wear black jazz shoes or any color ballet shoes. For Lyrical, dancers may wear any color ballet shoes or socks. For all non-ballet classes, hair is to be pulled back off of face.

Adult Beginner Ballet (Women & Men):

- Ballet attire is welcome, but not required. Most attendees wear general exercise clothing with socks or ballet shoes. Sneakers and mats for the cardio and floor barre portions of the Wednesday class are optional (and not necessary for the Saturday class).
